Dear Governor DeSantis,

I am Chaplain Rob Sugg, USAF (Retired). I am an ordained Minister of the Gospel in the Presbyterian Church (USA) and residing in Okaloosa County, Florida.

As your constituent, I am writing this letter to seek your support regarding our national constitutional crisis. Regardless of party affiliation, we all know that we are approaching the most important election of our lifetimes. In the past three months we have seen a dozen cities under siege; predominantly by young White aggressors in black-clad uniforms. They have been firebombing nightly and otherwise purposefully preventing our cities and nation to return to normal...and normal elections. The leaders of these organizations have *self-identified* as “Marxist” and “Anarchist.” They are directed and working in unison. Some of our mayors and governors have immediately brought in sufficient Law Enforcement and/or National Guard to squelch them while other treacherous mayors and governors have *provided support* for them.
